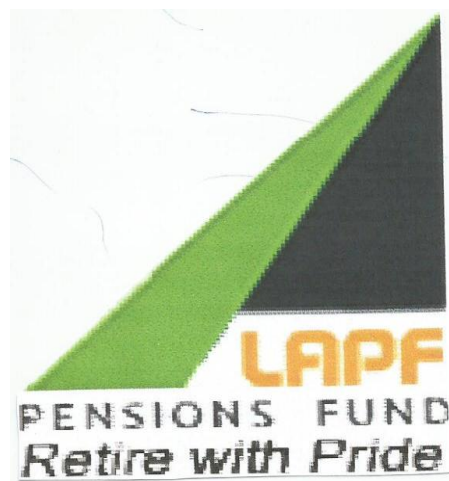

INVITATION FOR BIDS (IFB)

PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF MSAMVU BUS TERMINAL AT MOROGORO MUNICIPALITY-INFORMATION, COMMUNICATION AND TECHNOLOGY INSTALLATIONS WORKS (ICT).

- 0.0 This invitation for Bids follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) for this Project that appeared in the Daily News of Friday, 2nd September, 2011.
- 1.0 This tender was advertised in the newspaper (The Daily News) of 24th June, 2014. Due to non-responsiveness of the bids submitted by the bidders, the tender was annulled hence re-tendering. This tender is now re-advertised and is open to all potential and prospective bidders including those who initially participated in the annulled procurement proceedings.
- 2.0 The LAPF Pensions Fund on behalf of the Msamvu Properties Company (T) Limited, (MPCTL), (a Joint Venture between the LAPF Pensions Fund and Morogoro Municipal Council (MMC) has set aside funds from its budget for financing of the Proposed Construction of Msamvu Bus Terminal that will be situated at Msamvu (at the junction of Tanzam and Dodoma Highways area,

- Morogoro Municipality) intends to apply a portion of these funds to eligible payments under the contract for which this invitation for bids is issued.
- 3.0 Phase One of Msamvu Bus Terminal project shall comprise the following facilities with coverage of Four Thousand Four Hundred Thirty Seven square meter (4437sqm) of the building and Nine Thousand Three Hundred Fifty One square meter (9351sqm) of civil works:-
- (i) Booking Offices;
 - (ii) Passenger's Lounge;
 - (iii) Fast food kiosks;
 - (iv) Restaurant;
 - (v) Administration Offices;
 - (vi) Small & Medium size Shops;
 - (vii) Left luggage Storage Facilities;
 - (viii) External Works including Bus & Car Parking bays, Car wash, Pay to use toilets; Bank ATMs facilitation;
 - (ix) Associated services.
- 4.0 This invitation is open to all sub-contractors registered with the Contractors Registration Board of Tanzania in **class three and above to carry out Information, Communication & Technology Installations works** for the Proposed Construction of Msamvu Bus Terminal.
- 5.0 Bidding proceedings will be conducted through the procedures specified in Regulation stipulated in part VII of the Public Procurement (Goods, Works, Non-Consultant Services and Disposal of Public Assets by Tender) Government Notice 446 published on 20th December, 2013.
- 6.0 Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from and inspect the Tender Documents from the Secretary- LAPF Tender Board at the LAPF Pensions Fund upon submission of a written application to the Director General, LAPF Pension Fund, CDTF Building, Mtendeni Street, P.O. Box 1501, Dodoma, Telephone No. +255-26-2321952, from 0900 hours to 1600 hours during office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive except on Public Holidays.
- 7.0 A complete set of Bidding document(s) in English and additional sets may be purchased upon submission of a written application to the address given under paragraph six (6) above upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Tanzania shillings Two Hundred Thousands (**Tshs.200,000/=**). Payment should be deposited to CRDB Bank, **A/C No. 01j1081435900** payable to the Director General, LAPF Pensions Fund, P.O Box 1501, Dodoma.
- 8.0 All bids in **one original plus two copies**, properly filled in sealed envelopes must be accompanied by Bid Securing Declaration in the format provided in the bidding documents and properly addressed to the Director General, LAPF Pensions Fund, P.O. Box 1501 Dodoma.

- 9.0 Submission of bids must be received in sealed envelopes, which must be either delivered by hand or by registered mail to the secretary- LAPF Tender Board, LAPF Pensions Fund, CDTF Building, Mtendeni Street, P.O. Box 1501, Dodoma on or before **1000 hours local time on Friday, 15th April, 2015** and clearly marked ***“Construction of Msamvu Bus Terminal, Morogoro Municipality-Tender NO. PA095/HQ/2013/2014/W/06- Information, Communication & Technology Installations works and marked “Do not open before 1000 hours local time on 15th April, 2015.*** Bids will be opened immediately after submission deadline in public and in the presence of those applicants who will choose to attend, in the LAPF Boardroom located at the 2nd floor, CDTF Building, Mtendeni Street, Dodoma, Tanzania
- 10.0 Late bids, portion of bids, electronic bids and bids not received, not opened and or not read out in public at the opening ceremony shall not be considered for evaluation irrespective of the circumstances.
